Key Statistics

- 77% of people did not know they were overweight or obese Source: CMO
- 18.2% of year 6 children in Ashford were obese in 2014
 Source: Public Health England
- 22.7% of adults in Ashford were obese in 2014
 Source: PHE

Why are interventions not perceived as working/making a difference?

- Complex issues
- Results take years
- Organisations are not learning by mistakes
- Biggest concern =
- Lack of COMMUNICATION between Stakeholders





Concerns

- Professionals do not share information
- Referrals are inconsistent
- The community do not know about the 'offer'





Recommendations

- 'Whole systems' approach
- Develop a locally tailored plan
