VOICE Consortium

- VOICE brings together four local volunteer centres: Ashford, Dover, Shepway & Thanet plus Red Zebra Community Solutions. The Volunteer Centres have:
- Over 3000 volunteering contacts
- Actively support over a 1000 volunteers
- In the past year RED Zebra Community Solutions:
- Has supported over 300 VCSE's on a 1-to-1 basis
- Has Supported VCSE's to raise in excess of £1.2m

- Volunteer Contacts 772
- Volunteers actively supported 137


Red Zebra Community Solutions

 Has Supported Ashford VCSE's to raise in excess of £175,000

Red Zebra have made a return on investment of over £9 for every £1 of KCC funding "invested"



Challenges

- Reduction in Funding
- The sector workforce has grown by 24% since 1997, compared to 9% in the private sector and 16% in the public sector
- There are 160,000 charities in the UK 41% (or 68,000) have an income below £10k (Report by nfp Synergy, September 2015) outlines the scope and financial impact of the charity sector nationally, and these figures are representative of the Kent landscape.
- These smaller organisations provide vital local services but often lack the resources to identify funding and complete applications
- Smaller charities will close
- Local services will be lost

Red Zebra Community Solutions

Plays a vital role, facilitating increased effectiveness of frontline VCSEs and improving their resilience

Red Zebra provides:

- One-to-one support 'free at point of delivery'
- Networking opportunities
- Fundraising support
- Team building
- E-bulletins
- Workshops
- Liaison with statutory agencies
- Volunteer brokerage
- Support for Volunteer-Involving-Organisations (VIOs)

Recommendations

- Explore ways to engage meaningfully, with the VCSE as an equal partner and to develop joint initiatives to leverage in additional, external funding not accessible to the statutory sector
- Recognise the social and economic value of community based services that address social isolation, improve independence and reduce costs to statutory services
- Create an a 'resilience' funding to support smaller organisations
- Change how VCSEs are funded; longer term funding that enables organisations to make strategic decisions and to respond to statutory sector objectives
- Develop a social prescribing scheme for Ashford
- Work with the VCSE to better understand economic savings to the system
