What's going on in our world	Stop Smoking Campaign — Developments for a newly commissioned Kent-wide campaign to help raise the profile of stop smoking services and to develop new ways that can help people quit (such as quit packs and e-cigarette support). Ashford District has seen the sharpest increase in smoking prevalence in Kent in the last year so campaign resources will be targeted in the Ashford district as well as other areas of high prevalence.
	Smoking in Pregnancy – Kent Public Health and East Kent Hospitals University Foundation Trust are co-appointing a midwife with a specialism of reducing smoking in pregnancy. The post will be appointed in April and will support and train midwives to implement the babyClear programme and network with other relevant health professionals to tackle smoking in pregnancy prevalence in the East Kent Hospitals Trust.
