REPRESENTATIVES ON OUTSIDE BODIES/ORGANISATIONS

Details of Outside Bodies/Organisations to which the Council makes appointments are detailed in the attached table. The Committee is asked to make nominations as indicated. Additional information is given below regarding: - the Ashford Almshouses and Parochial Charities; the Julie Rose Memorial Athletics Stadium Management Company; the River Stour Internal Drainage Board; and the South East England Regional Assembly (SEERA).

Ashford Almshouses and Parochial Charities

Councillor Kemp and Mr Lawrie's five year appointments expire on the 31st May 2009. Mr Lawrie has recently moved away from the area so a replacement for that position is sought. The Clerk of the Charities had indicated that they would be happy for Councillor Kemp to be re-appointed to his position if this is the wish of the Borough Council.

Julie Rose Memorial Athletics Stadium Management Company

Councillor Honey has resigned as a Trustee for this organisation therefore a replacement nomination needs to be made.

River Stour Internal Drainage Board

Traditionally the Council has appointed three Members and two outside people to this Board. When Mr Boulden resigned last year the National Farmers Union was unable to nominate a replacement at the time and the Council nominated Cllr Mrs Marriott to take the fifth position. The NFU have subsequently given the name of a local landowner, Mr Peter Howard of Bockhanger Farms Hothfield, who would be interested in filling the vacancy. The Committee is therefore asked to consider this nomination and the make up of the Council's five appointees.

South East England Regional Assembly (SEERA)

SEERA was dissolved on the 31st March 2009 as a result of the Government's plans to streamline regional working arrangements, as part of its Sub-National Review of Economic Development and Regeneration. The work of SEERA will largely be subsumed by a new body known as South East England Councils (SEEC), therefore the Council's appointments have been amended accordingly.

Members are reminded of the requirement to produce an Annual Report of the Organisations/Outside Bodies they are appointed to.
