546 Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 – Councillor Call for Action and New Scrutiny Functions

The report provided an overview of the principal new functions for scrutiny arising from the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 and the Police and Justice Act 2006 and advised of the need to amend the Terms of Reference of the Overview & Scrutiny Committee to take account of these changes, together with other consequential changes to the Council's Constitution.

A Member said he had concerns about the ability of the County Council to set up Joint Overview & Scrutiny Committees with the Districts. In his view there was a need to proceed with caution as other Joint Committees set up by the County Council had not involved equal working. The Leader said he viewed this more positively as it was giving the Districts a voice and a vote on issues which they may previously not have had. There was a requirement for the County Council, and other partners, to make information available to a District's Overview & Scrutiny

Committee in relation to targets within the Local Area Agreement as well as other information which could help the work of the Overview & Scrutiny Committee more generally.

Recommended:

- That (i) the Overview & Scrutiny Committee's Terms of Reference be amended to include responsibility for considering "Councillor Call for Action" under the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007.
 - (ii) the Overview & Scrutiny Committee be designated as the Committee responsible for Crime and Disorder issues under the Police and Justice Act 2006 and the Terms of Reference be amended to reflect this.
 - (iii) The Head of Legal & Democratic Services report to a future meeting of the Selection & Constitutional Review Committee and the Overview & Scrutiny Committee with a suggested protocol for Members regarding the handling of "Councillor Calls for Action".

547 Background and Principles of Political Balance and Administrative Structure

The Head of Legal & Democratic Services presented the Political Balance for the Authority and sought to agree a number of other constitutional matters which needed to be recommended to the Annual Meeting of the Council on the 14th May 2009.

Recommended:
