528 Minutes

Resolved:

That the Minutes of the meeting of this Committee held on the 4th February 2010 be approved and confirmed as a correct record.

529 Independent Members of the Standards Committee – Extension of Terms of Appointment

The report sought Council agreement to extend the terms of appointment of the Independent Members of the Standards Committee for a further four year term to 1st May 2014.

A Member said that he felt the Independent Members should change from time to time and in his opinion appointing for a further four year period was too long. On a wider issue he also considered there should be a review of the hearings process as in his opinion some questionable procedures existed. Members who made complaints could not be party to the Assessment Panel proceedings or have copies of the Monitoring Officer's report and did not have any recourse if they disagreed with the Panels' decisions. With regard to the terms of appointment the Monitoring Officer explained that there were a number of reasons for recommending reappointment for a further four years. The current members had served the Committee well and provided good and independent scrutiny on a number of cases. There was no requirement to extend the appointments for a full four years but Independent Members were particularly difficult to recruit and the Committee was lucky to have the existing three. The Chairman said that perhaps two year appointments would be a better solution. Other Members suggested that perhaps the appointments should be staggered so that the Committee did not lose three experienced members all at the same time. It was agreed to extend the three appointments for a further two years each, and then explore the options for staggering the expiration of the appointments after that.

With regard to the procedure for hearings the Monitoring Officer said that as far as he was aware the Member was the only one who had expressed these concerns and all the procedures complied with statutory regulations laid down by Government. He had already offered a meeting with the Member to explain the procedures for the local assessment of Code of Conduct complaints and the guidelines that had been set down. He was still particularly keen to have that meeting. The Committee agreed that this meeting should take place and if following that it was felt that there was a need to further debate the issue, it could come back to Members.

Recommended:

That the terms of appointment for the Independent Members of the Standards Committee, namely Mrs Carol Vant, Mr Mike Sharpe and Mr John Dowsey, be extended to the 1st May 2012 and that consideration be given to staggering the expiration of appointments thereafter.

Resolved:

That the Monitoring Officer meet with Councillor Davison to discuss the procedure for Standards Committee hearings.

530 Formation of a Grants Gateway Panel

The report recommended changes to the membership of the Community Grants Panel and new terms of reference to allow extension of its remit to consider grants gateway allocations for 2011-2012 and onwards. Known as the Grants Gateway Panel, the Panel would retain responsibility for recommending Community Grants Fund allocations. The Grants Gateway Panel would meet three times a year in May, October and January to consider Community Grants, and once per year starting in September 2010 to consider Single Grants Gateway allocations for the following financial year.

The Chairman drew attention to the tabled papers which included a proposed amendment to the first paragraph of the Terms of Reference. A Member said that the second paragraph was redundant and should be removed.

Recommended:

That the new Terms of Reference be agreed to enable the formation of a Grants Gateway Panel.

531 Handling of the Annual Governance Statement

The report recommended changes to the handling of the Annual Governance Statement which would require amendments to the Terms of Reference of both the Audit Committee and the Selection & Constitutional Review Committee.

Recommended:

That the Audit Committee be responsible for recommending the Annual Governance Statement for approval to the Executive (currently delegated to the Selection & Constitutional Review Committee) and that the Council discontinues preparing and approving a separate Statement on Internal Control (as this is part of the Annual Governance Statement).

532 Background and Principles of Political Balance and Administrative Structure

The Head of Legal & Democratic Services presented the Political Balance for the Authority and sought to agree a number of other constitutional matters which needed to be recommended to the Annual Meeting of the Council on the 13th May 2010. The Chairman directed Members attention to the tabled papers which included a revised Appendix B to the report to take into account the proposed Conservative Membership of Committees and an addition to Appendix D outlining an additional delegation to the Development Control Manager/Strategic Sites & Design Manager.

Recommended:

- That (i) the Political Balance of the Authority as contained in Appendix A to these Minutes be adopted, subject to the Council agreeing that the requirements of the Political Balance Regulations be not applied to the Membership of the Appeals and the Audit Committee and the Sub-Committee of the Licensing and Health & Safety Committee established under the Licensing Act 2003 and Gambling Act 2005.
 - (ii) the size of the Executive be eight Members, i.e. a Leader and seven Portfolio Holders.
 - (iii) the split of functions of Executive Members be as set out below: -

Leader of the Council Resource Management and Control Strategic Planning Cultural Services and IT Development Management Environmental Services and IT Housing and Customer Services Community and Communications.

- (iv) the SRA payable to the newly created Development Management Portfolio be at the same level currently paid to existing Portfolio Holders.
- (v) the Constitution Part 3 Responsibility for Functions, Appendix 2 – Executive Functions (Split) General, be amended to authorise the Deputy Leader to act as the Leader when the Leader is absent or unable to act. A note to the same effect be added as a footnote to the Leader Portfolio.
- (vi) it be agreed that the Member to be appointed to the ex-officio position on the Planning Committee will be the Portfolio Holder for Development Management with the Portfolio Holder for Strategic Planning being the substitute for the ex-officio position.
- (vii) the following Committees be constituted for the 2010/11 Municipal Year as detailed in Part 3 of the Constitution:

Audit Overview and Scrutiny Planning Selection and Constitutional Review Licensing and Health & Safety Appointments Appeals Standards (including an Assessment Panel; a Hearings Panel and a Review Panel) Joint Arrangements – Joint Transportation Board

NB: Details of Members appointed to Membership of each Committee etc by Group Leaders is shown at Appendix B to these Minutes. Note: This will be subject to amendments from Group Leaders.

- (viii) the Council appoint the Chairmen and Vice Chairmen for each Committee etc as shown in Appendix B.
- (ix) the Scheme of Executive and Council Delegations as set out in Part 3 of the Constitution be reaffirmed, subject to the inclusion of the changes set out within Appendix D to the report and the Additional Papers in respect of the Development Control Manager/Strategic Sites & Design Manager.
- (x) the intention of the Executive to reconstitute the Forums and Groups as listed in Part 3 Appendix 2 to the Constitution be noted.

533 Representatives on Outside Bodies/Organisations

The report of the Head of Legal & Democratic Services gave details of those organisations or outside bodies to which the Council appointed or nominated representatives, and the names of the Members of the Council and others who currently served in this capacity. Details of attendance by this Council's appointed representatives at meetings of the organisations during the past year (where known) and retirement dates were also shown. The covering report also provided additional information about the Ashford's Future Partnership and Company Boards, the Kennington Parochial Charities and the SWAN Centre Site Management Committee.

Resolved:

That the names of the persons to be appointed or nominated as Members or Substitute Members (as the case may be) to the organisations listed in Appendix C to these Minutes be agreed.

534 Annual Meeting – Order of Proceedings

The Committee considered the Order of Proceedings for the Annual Meeting of the Council including the movers and seconders of the Mayor, Deputy Mayor and the vote of thanks to the retiring Mayor. The Committee also discussed which Members would be the movers and seconders for the Election of the Leader of the Council, Deputy Leader of the Council and the Executive Members.

That the Head of Legal & Democratic Services prepare the Order of Proceedings for the Annual Meeting of the Council on the basis of the advice of this Committee.
