406 Background and Principles of Political Balance and Administrative Structure

The Member Services Manager introduced the report which presented the Political Balance for the Authority and sought to agree a number of other constitutional matters which needed to be recommended to the Annual Meeting of the Council on the 30th May 2023. The agreed Political Balance is contained at Appendix A to these Minutes. He also drew the Committee's attention to the tabled paper which included some revised recommendations and consequential changes to the Appendices to the report. The new Appendices included proposals following input from Group Leaders.

The Chairman ran through the membership of Committees, Groups, Panels and Boards one by one. With input from Members, the proposed membership for 2023/24 was completed including the nominations for Chairmen and Vice-Chairmen. This is contained at Appendix B to these Minutes. The Chairman explained that given the unique circumstances of this year, the appointments could be considered as 'placeholders' with a recognition that these may need to be reviewed following the election of the Leader of the Council.

Recommended:

That (i) the Committee recommends to Council the adoption of the Political Balance of the Authority as contained at Appendix A to these Minutes, and that the Council agrees that the requirements of the Political Balance Regulations be not applied to the Membership of the Joint Transportation Board, the Appeals Committee and its Panels, the Investigation and Disciplinary Committee (and its Panels), the Standards Committee, and the Sub-Committees of the Licensing and Regulatory Committees established under the Licensing Act 2003 and Gambling Act 2005.

(ii) the Committee recommends to Council that the following Committees be constituted for the Municipal Year as detailed in Part 3 of the Constitution:

- (iv) the Committee recommends that the Council re-appoints Mrs Carol Vant as the Independent Person for a further period to the end of the next Council in May 2027.**

407 Appointment of Members of, or Liaison Members to, Outside Bodies

The report gave details of those outside bodies or organisations to which the Council made appointments, either as members of those bodies, or (in almost all cases) as Liaison Members to those bodies. It was explained that all appointments (whether continuing or new) would be made in line with the decision at the Council Meeting of 27th April 2023. This was explained further in the report. Details of attendance by the Council's appointed representatives at meetings of the organisations during the past year (where known) were also shown.

The Solicitor to the Council and Monitoring Officer advised that as Cllr Peter Feacey had been appointed to the Ashford Volunteer Centre as a Trustee in his own right, it would be sensible to leave the Liaison Member appointment vacant for the timebeing.

Recommended:

That (i) the Council is minded to appoint: -

- (a) the members and Replacement members (as stated) of the organisations listed in Appendix C to these Minutes, and**
- (b) the Liaison Members to work with the organisations listed in Appendix C to these Minutes,**

in both cases subject to the prior receipt, to the satisfaction of the Solicitor to the Council and Monitoring Officer, of written confirmation from the organisation of the relevant matters as described in Paragraph 3 of the report.

- (ii) **the Council delegate the making of the formal appointments as above to the Solicitor to the Council and Monitoring Officer and Member Services Manager, subject to receipt of the confirmation described above to his satisfaction.**
- (iii) **the Council delegate to the Solicitor to the Council and Monitoring Officer and Member Services Manager the powers to:-**
 - (a) **formally confirm in writing to the outside bodies and outgoing appointees the cessation of previous appointments which are being considered for replacement by new appointments;**
 - (b) **should the required confirmations not be received from the organisations after reasonable efforts have been exhausted, terminate previous appointments which are being considered for renewal as recommended in the report.**
