(a) <u>Disclosable Pecuniary Interests (DPI)</u> under the Localism Act 2011, relating to items on this agenda. The <u>nature</u> as well as the existence of any such interest must be declared, and the agenda item(s) to which it relates must be stated.

A Member who declares a DPI in relation to any item will need to leave the meeting for that item (unless a relevant Dispensation has been granted).

(b) Other Significant Interests (OSI) under the Kent Code of Conduct relating to items on this agenda. The <u>nature</u> as well as the existence of any such interest must be declared, and the agenda item(s) to which it relates must be stated.

A Member who declares an OSI in relation to any item will need to leave the meeting <u>before</u> the <u>debate and vote</u> on that item (unless a relevant Dispensation has been granted). However, prior to leaving, the Member may address the Committee in the same way that a member of the public may do so.

- (c) <u>Voluntary Announcements of Other Interests</u> not required to be disclosed under (a) and (b), i.e. announcements made for transparency alone, such as:
 - Membership of amenity societies, Town/Community/Parish Councils, residents' groups or other outside bodies that have expressed views or made representations, but the Member was not involved in compiling or making those views/representations, or
 - Where a Member knows a person involved, but does <u>not</u> have a close association with that person, or
 - Where an item would affect the well-being of a Member, relative, close associate, employer, etc. but <u>not</u> his/her financial position.

[Note: Where an item would be likely to affect the <u>financial position</u> of a Member, relative, close associate, employer, etc.; OR where an item is <u>an application made</u> by a Member, relative, close associate, employer, etc., there is likely to be an OSI or in some cases a DPI. ALSO, holding a committee position/office within an amenity society or other outside body, or having any involvement in compiling/making views/representations by such a body, may give rise to a perception of bias and require the Member to take no part in any motion or vote.]

377 A Better Choice for Property Ltd – Land at Charing

The Deputy Chief Executive introduced the confidential report which provided an update on the proposed purchase of the development site first presented to the Board in 2018.

An amendment to one of the recommendations was agreed to require a further report and construction plan once RIBA stage 4 had been reached. Following a lengthy discussion, the Board agreed the amended recommendations. The Board was mindful in its decision, ensuring that modelling had been updated and was reflective of the current economic environment.

Resolved:

(i) That the TEB notes the progress of the project as outlined in the attached Company Board Report.

Recommended:

That Cabinet

- a) Agree that the company continues to promote this scheme, subject to a new loan agreement being put in place with the Council and to planning approval being obtained by the Company in due course.
- b) Agree to increase the funding allocated to the scheme to £21m (from £15.7m) with up to £400,000 to be drawn to complete

works necessary to commence construction (e.g. Archaeology, Environmental mitigation, further planning submissions etc.), both to be set out in a new loan agreement for Development schemes between the Council and the Company in compliance with the Subsidy Control Act 2022.

- c) Require a further report and construction plan when the Company has reached a RIBA stage 4 and is ready to commence construction which will be independently reviewed.
- d) Authorise the Solicitor to the Council and Monitoring Officer to negotiate, finalise and complete all necessary legal agreements and other documents to give effect to the above.

378 A Better Choice for Property Ltd – Portfolio Update

The Operations Manager (A Better Choice for Property Ltd) introduced the update, providing an overview of void times, rental income and arrears. The rental market was buoyant with demand for property in prime locations high.
